



BRIT Kids AEN (SEN) Policy

When applying to BRIT Kids should your child have Additional Educational Needs, this should be explained in full on the application form. The child's AEN will be reviewed by the senior leadership team, depending on the AEN needs, the carer will be called to discuss how best BRIT kids can cater for them.

Should a child attend a specialist school, it may be necessary for a 1:1 to be allocated to them. This comes at an additional cost. This will be decided through carer discussions and lesson observations.

All children with AEN needs that impact on their time at BRIT kids both socially and educationally will be added to the teacher AEN list. This list outlines the child's AEN needs and notes any particular challenges to aid our teachers deal with your child appropriately.

By disclosing an AEN need you will not affect your child's application process and allocation.
