



BRIT Kids Disruptive Student Policy

General misbehaviour should be dealt with in lesson by the teacher. If there is a persistent offender that is not responding to teacher instruction a manager will be informed and parents/guardians will be called.

Alongside this, should a child misbehave in the classroom and is disrupting the class, they can be removed from the class. The parent/guardian will be called and the child's name will be logged in our Disruptive Student Folder. The child will be asked to sit out of the class and will be allowed to re-join their next class.

If the student persists to cause problems in weeks to follow, the Teacher is to notify a Saturday Manager or Director

Action: Manager to call parent and arrange meeting to discuss problems. This should be logged with the Director and, if thought fit, issue a Final warning, a letter stating this will also be issued by the Director. A final warning will remain active for a year.

If the student persists to cause problems.

Action: Student asked to leave Brit Kids by letter, which should offer a meeting so that the decision can be explained to them (NOT discussed).

Stages may be missed out in the event of serious misconduct. Examples may include bullying, swearing, leaving campus without authority, violence, stealing, and threats.
